Student Demographics

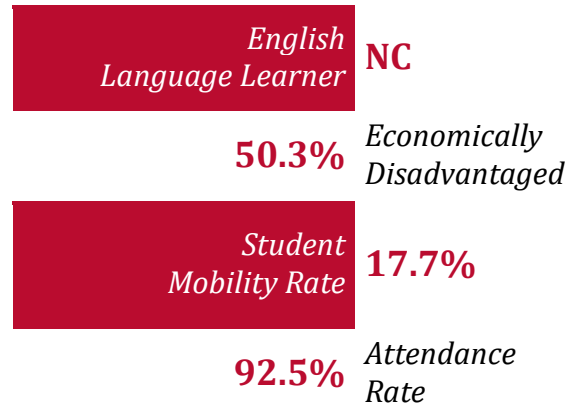

The percentage of students proficient in **English Language Arts** increased from **87.5%** to **94.4%** from SY 2024 to SY 2025.

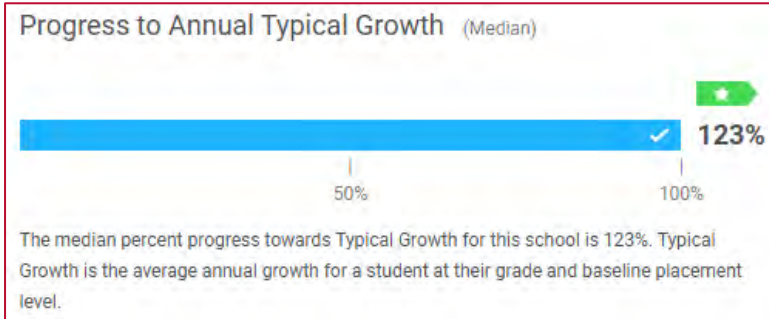

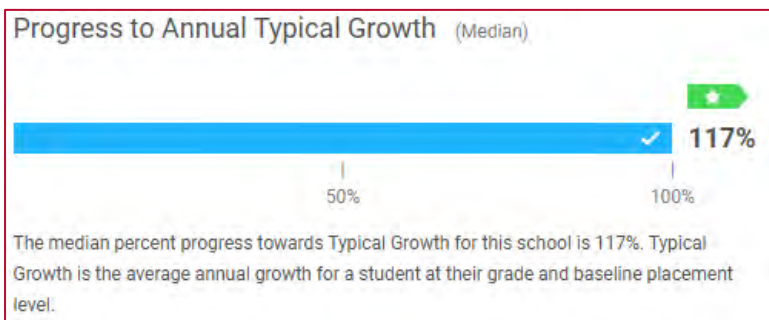

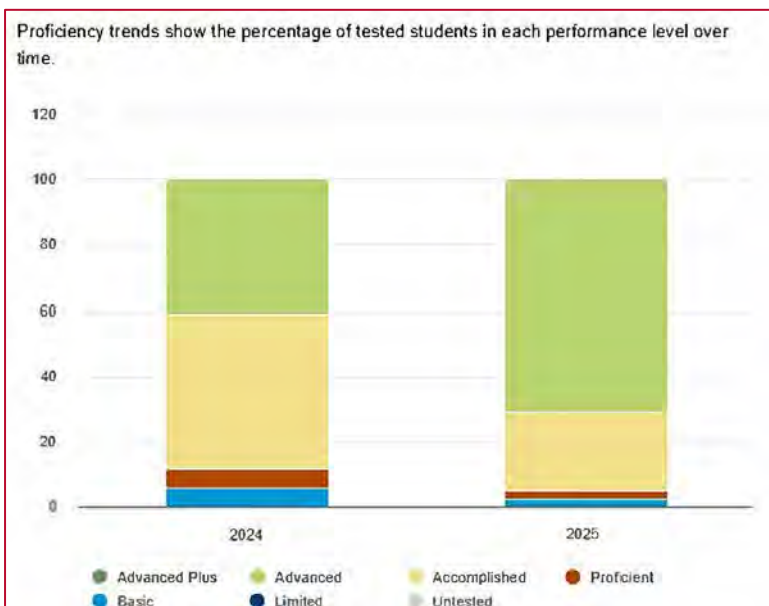
iReady Data Reading

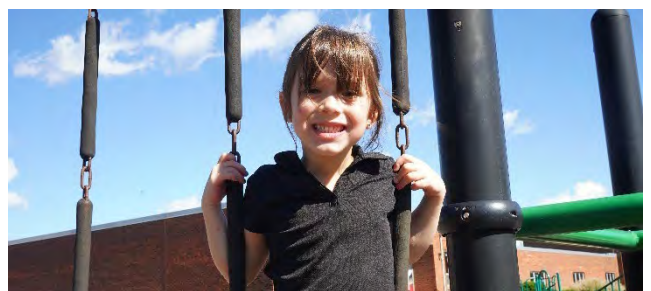
